The Pre-A Level Course

The Pre A level Course consists of IGCSE Maths, two Sciences (Physics and Chemistry), English as a Second Language and Computing.

Time is also set aside for a great deal of additional English Language work and a project based study designed to introduce students to culture and life in the UK. Lessons are organised with those students taking a full GCSE programme as well as some extra sessions specifically designed for these students.

Students following this course will be full members of the College, part of a tutor group, members of a House taking part in games and activities, and everything else that goes on in a busy boarding school.



This course is designed to prepare students to take a full suite of A Levels (usually 3 or 4 subjects) in readiness for study at a UK University. It is particularly helpful for those whose English is not yet sufficiently confident or advanced for independent study, particularly for those wanting to do A Level subjects where much reading and writing is required.



The course is also of benefit to those who are still undecided as to which A Levels to study and by providing opportunity to gain some GCS's , will make processes of University application much more straightforward.

Suitability for this course is decided through discussion and is dependent on the assessment and Skype interview held on application.

Students completing this course would normally move to a full A level course provided they have reached an appropriate standard.
